



Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life... John 6:27

I hear it whenever my wife sends me to the grocery store. "Remember," she calls out to me, "get the milk and bread from the back!" Reach into the back of the shelf, check the dates tagged on the containers and get the stuff that will last longest.

In today's Gospel, Jesus offers us a similar lesson. His listeners must have been amazed to hear him offering bread that wouldn't go bad, "The true bread from heaven."




