

- \*Cantors
- \*Lectors
- \*Choir Members (only if there are youth members)
- Complete the Online CASE Training, test and PRINT out your Certificate at <a href="http://ec.dor.org">http://ec.dor.org</a>
- 2. Print and Sign the Volunteer Code of Conduct to be placed with your CASE Certificate
- Complete the Consent for Background Check (bringing your valid ID to our office when turning in the paperwork.)
