## ***The Most Holy Trinity***

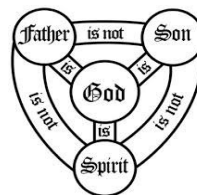
*Come, Holy Spirit!*

*Trinity Sunday celebrates the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, the three Persons of God: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.*

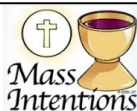
*Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we affirm our belief in the doctrine that in one God, there are three persons. The words taken directly from today's Gospel, in which Jesus sends forth His apostles to preach and baptize everywhere until the end of time. The action accompanying these words—tracing the hand from the forehead, to the breast, then to the left and right shoulders—reminds us that it is through the Cross of Jesus, the Son of God made man, that the life of the Trinity is opened to us and the Cross is the only means by which we can follow Christ our Savior and Lord to enter into eternal life.*

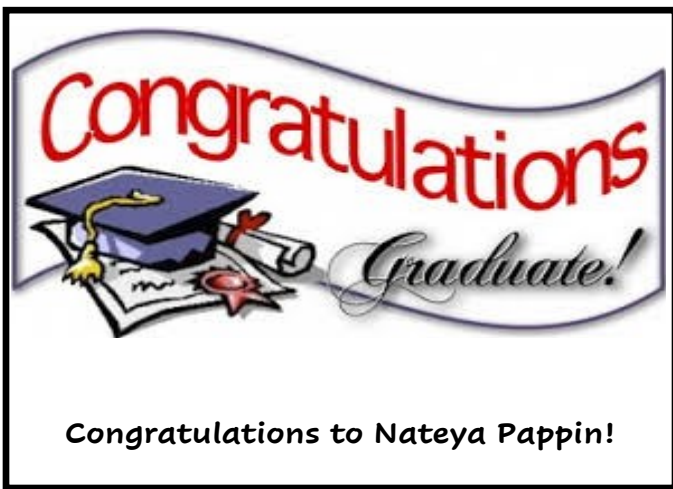
